LFCS 2016-2017 EPA Expenditure Report

The Education Protection Act requires the combined efforts of staff, administrators, and parents to determine how the Education Protection Act (EPA) revenues will be expensed.

The language in Proposition 30 requires that the funds *not* be used for administrative salaries or other administrative costs. There is also a requirement that Charter Schools post on their website annually an accounting of how much EPA money was received and how it was spent.

The 2016-17 expenditure report is consistent with the 2016-17 budget plan for EPA revenue, which dedicated EPA revenue to pay for the cost of teacher salaries and related costs. The following expenditure report shows the details of how the money was spent in the 2016-17 school year.
